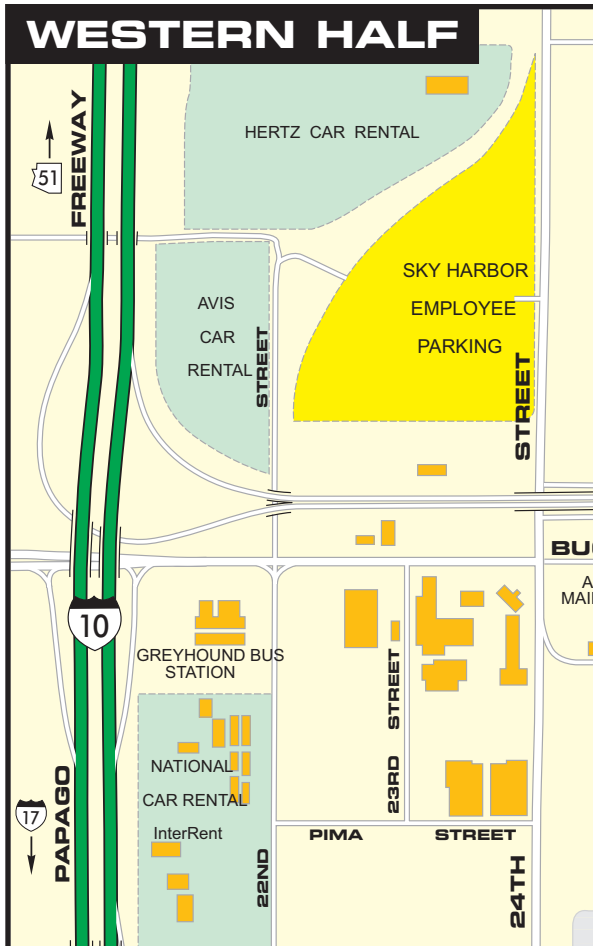


Sky Harbor International Airport

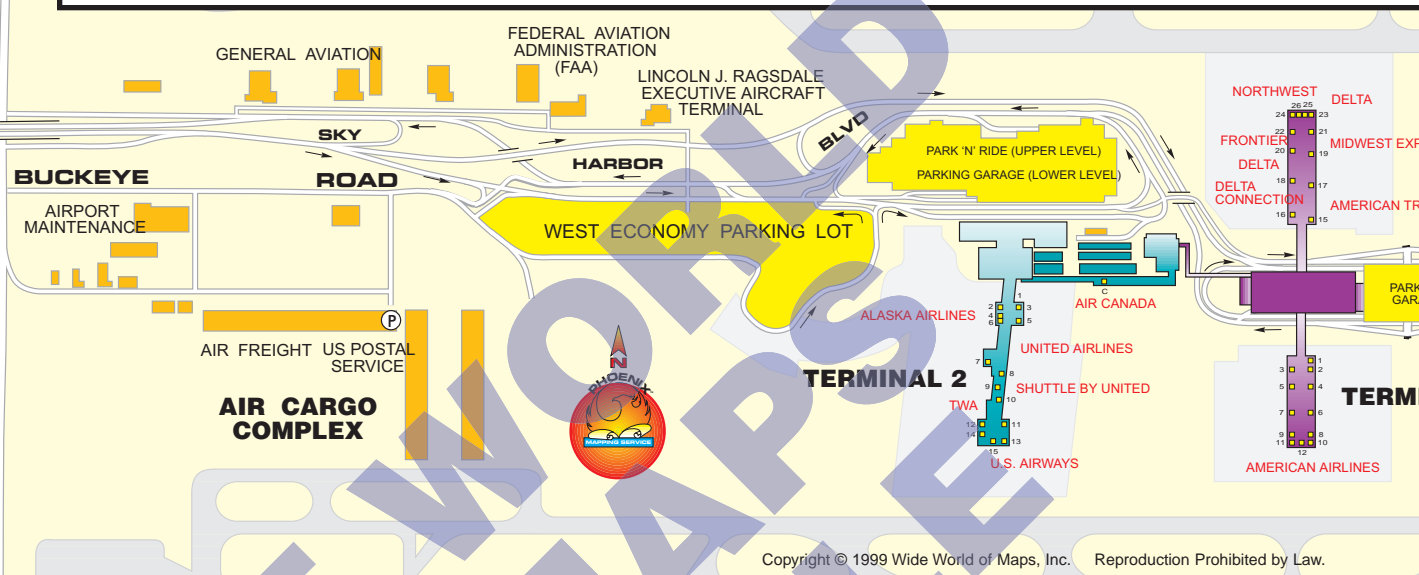


Depicted is the principal road network through Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport, with major building and parking areas identified. Additionally, the freeway and surface street accesses to each end of the airport are detailed.

Due to scale restrictions, the airport is shown in two sections: this section details the western half, while the section below covers the eastern half.

On the west, the Papago Freeway (I-10) provides the shortest and quickest route to the downtown Phoenix area and the western portion of the "Valley of the Sun." It conveniently interchanges with the Squaw Peak Parkway (AZ 51) shortly after leaving the airport for those traveling to north-central Phoenix. Buckeye Road and 24th Street provide access to both Interstates 10 and 17 for fast transit to other areas of the city.

The airport parking lots provide economical parking for the air traveler. A Park 'N Ride lot is located on the top level of the Terminal 2 Parking Garage, while the West Economy Parking Lot is located on the east end of the airport. Free shuttle transportation to each of the three terminals and the Ragsdale Executive Aircraft Terminal is available continuously 24 hours a day. Parking is also available adjacent to each of the terminals, as well as a multi-level garage above Goldwater Terminal 4.

On the east, several major thoroughfares can be accessed directly for travel to eastern areas of the Valley. The Hohokam Expressway (AZ 143) connects to the south with I-10 and US 60 for the quickest routes to Tempe, Mesa, Chandler and Gilbert, as well as Tucson (120 miles). The Sky Harbor Expressway (AZ 153) takes the traveler north to the Red Mountain Freeway (AZ 202) for access to Scottsdale, Paradise Valley and the remainder of Phoenix.

The Goldwater Terminal 4 has a dual-level roadway that separates the loading and unloading areas:

the **UPPER LEVEL** is for **DEPARTING** passengers.

the **LOWER LEVEL** for **ARRIVING** passengers.

This terminal also contains the International Concourse for passengers arriving in or departing from the United States.

Parking, road and other conditions broadcast continuously on the Airport Travelers Information Service, 1610 on the AM band.

For your convenience, car rental counters are located in all the terminals at Phoenix Sky Harbor Int'l Airport.
